

DME - General Information – Autumn Admission Round

ENROLLMENT CONDITIONS

The right to enroll in the University's integrated undergraduate and graduate study in Dental Medicine in English is granted to candidates who have passed the Entrance Exam, the State Matura Examination and the Psychomotor Ability Test in addition to fulfilling other prerequisites for enrollment. For the purpose of applying to the Autumn Admission Round, it is obligatory to send the completed application form and proof of payment of the 200,00 EUR application fee to dme@sfzg.hr.

PREREQUISITES FOR ENROLLMENT

- Certificate from the competent school doctor about the health and psychophysical abilities to study Dental Medicine University's integrated undergraduate and graduate study
- signed Declaration of psychophysical ability to exercise the title of Doctor of dental medicine
- Proof of English language proficiency (level B2 or C1)

PAID PLACE RESERVATION

The candidates who pass the knowledge test in Biology, Physics and Chemistry successfully and submit all required documents shall be offered admission to the DME integrated undergraduate and graduate study. Proof of tuition payment should be sent to: dme@sfzg.hr. If the tuition fee is not paid on time, the candidate's place shall be offered to the next applicant on the ranking list.

ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

The ranking list of registered candidates for admission to the study program is compiled according to the following scoring system:

- a) Written exam in Biology, Chemistry and Physics (120 questions in total with the minimum of 40% of the written exam)
- b) Verification of special abilities - Psychomotor test conducted by the School of Dental Medicine (up to 100 points, minimum for the Psychomotor test is 15 points)
- c) High school grades, as well as success in the State Matura Examination (Level B) are **not** taken into account when compiling the candidate ranking list

Applications are submitted through the state graduation system for Dental Medicine **until August 29th 2025**.

Additional documentation and applications for verification of special abilities are submitted electronically: all scanned documents shall be sent to dme@sfzg.hr **from August 21st 2025 to August 29th 2025**.

Entrance exams will be held on September 9th 2025 in Zagreb.

Additional documentation to be submitted:

a. Certificate from the competent school doctor on health and psychophysical abilities for the study of Dental Medicine

Applicants who have completed High school or have previously studied in the Republic of Croatia, must undergo an examination for the issuance of a Certificate of Psychophysical Abilities for the study of Dental Medicine at the competent school doctors (for High school or Faculty).

Applicants can find information on the examination and issuance of certificates for enrollment in a higher education institution on the websites of the county public health institutes (School and adolescent medicine service).

b. Statement of psychophysical abilities

c. Application for testing special abilities

d. **Confirmation of payment** (completed application and proof of payment of the costs of testing special abilities in the amount of 40,00 EUR must be attached. An amount of 40,00 EUR shall be paid to IBAN HR7423600001101235285 University of Zagreb School of Dental Medicine with the indication "For psychomotor ability test".

Applicants coming from countries where there is no school and adolescent medicine service (e.g. Bosnia and Herzegovina) must pass the examination for issuing the Certificate of Health and Psychophysical Abilities for the study of dental medicine performed at the nearest school and adolescent medicine outpatient clinic at the public health institutes in the Republic of Croatia or at the outpatient clinic of the Center for Health Services of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Zagreb.

Bookings for an examination appointment at the Center for Health Services of the School of Medicine of the University of Zagreb with Assoc. Prof. Marjeta Majer, MD, specialist in school and adolescent medicine, are accepted by e-mail: mmajer@snz.hr. **When ordering an examination at the Center, it is necessary to attach a scan of the following documents:**

- 1.** Questionnaire for issuing a Certificate of Health and Psychophysical Abilities from the Competent School Physician for the 2025-26 study period
- 2.** Certificate from a general practitioner/family medicine or pediatrician (not related to the applicant) on health status and previous illnesses
- 3.** Certificate of vaccinations in preschool and school age (with the specified vaccines and date of receipt)
- 4.** Medical documentation for previously identified illnesses and health disorders with recent findings.

Only candidates who have applied in time in the specified manner and sent all additional documentation in accordance with the instructions above, have the right to access the Psychomotor ability test.

After receiving and processing an application, candidates will be sent a password to the e-mail address provided in the "POSTANI STUDENT" system. It is strongly recommended that candidates memorize their password, because without it access to the Psychomotor ability test shall be denied.

Detailed information about Psychomotor skills test (c) is published on the website of the School of Dental Medicine (www.sfzg.unizg.hr).

The Psychomotor ability test (c) will be conducted on **September 5th 2025, at the School of Dental Medicine Gundulićeva 3, 1st floor, Computer room, Zagreb** and details shall be provided by email.

A candidate who has not completed two years of Latin language course must pass Latin language course prior to enrollment in the second year of studies.

Enrollment quotas

Enrollment quotas are determined each year for the upcoming academic year.

A total of 8 students are planned to be enrolled in the upcoming enrollment period.

The admission procedure

1. Send the application form (can be downloaded from www.sfzg.unizg.hr website) and proof of payment of 200,00 EUR to the following email address: dme@sfzg.hr
2. Attend the Entrance exam and obtain the required number of points
3. Apply throughout the State Matura system (until August 29th 2025)
4. Apply for the Psychomotor ability test and submit additional documentation exclusively through the School of Dental Medicine (August 21st 2025 – August 29th 2025). The timetable for candidates for the Psychomotor test (that shall be held on September 5th 2025) shall be provided by email.

Enrollment in the 1st year of Dental Medicine in English studies is on September 19th 2025.
